He likes to work on new plays, classics and modern classics (of which *Copenhagen* may be one.) In the bay area he has directed numerous staged readings and directed the workshop premiere of *Bad Connection?* at West Valley College in Saratoga. He has been an assistant director at such theaters as ACT, The Old Globe in San Diego, the Kirk Douglas Theatre in LA, La Jolla Playhouse and Berkeley Opera. He is a TBA ATLAS fellow, was awarded a SDCF Observership (with Chay Yew), and attended Directors Lab West and Directors Lab Chicago.

Robert Ernst* (Niels Bohr) is a co-founder of the Berkeley-based Blake Street Hawkeyes and the Iowa Theater Lab. Theatre. He last appeared at Theater Works in *Proof*. Other selected stage roles include: *The Time of Your Life* at ACT and Seattle Rep. Theater, *Speed of Darkness* and *People's Temple* at Berkeley Rep, *Red State* at The S.F. Mime Troupe, and *Play-land* and *The Joy of Going Somewhere Definite* at The Magic Theater. Robert is the author of a number of well-received pocket operas - *The John* (Intersection for the Arts), *Catherine's Care*, and his latest, *Changer* (Alter Theater of San Rafael). He received Dramalogue awards for Best Director and Best Production for *Tokens*. Robert performed non-stop for twenty-four hours and one minute, besting the existing record for longest play. Selected television and film credits include: *Hill Street Blues*, *Valley of the Heart's Delight*, *Jumpin' Jack Flash* and *Surefire* (Caligari Film, Berlin Film Festival) He teaches playwriting and acting at CTE, Tamalpais High School and is also a member of the band, Smooth Toad.

Karol Strempke (Margarethe Borh) began acting in Bay Area theatres over thirty years ago - through the years she has performed at Contra Costa Civic, Masquers, Hillbarn, Ross Valley Players, Altarena, Chanticleers, Marin Shakespeare Festival, Pacific Coast Repertory Theatre and Theatre First. She has trained at ACT, University of Washington and received her MFA from the University of Wisconsin where her studies focused on classical theatre. Most recently she performed the roles of Fraulein Schneider in *Cabaret*, and Matron Momma Morten in *Chicago!* for PCRT, and Madge in the Bay Area premier of Welcome Home Jenny Sutter for TheatreFirst.
