Cast and Crew Biographies

Bill Chessman (*Harry*) is a writer/actor/director who has worked on both sides of the SF Bay, both sides of the Atlantic Ocean and both sides of Interstate 80 including **AEB** in staged readings and full productions. He also writes, directs and acts in radio plays.

New to the Bay area, she lived in L.A. for the last eighteen years where she was an active member, onstage and off, of the Actor's Co-op. A few credits: *33 Variations*, *Lend Me a Tenor*, *Rabbit Hole*, and *The Baby Dance*.


